Do you think that children do not have enough opportunities to hear Bible stories and learn about Jesus? Would you be willing to give a little time, within a team, to help with this?



With the ever-growing activities available for children and young people in the area, we are investigating the possibility of becoming involved in a project called Open the Book.

Open the Book is a project run by The Bible Society where groups of volunteers from churches go into schools and tell stories of the Bible. These stories are told in a dramatised way, using drama, props and interacting with pupils and teachers enabling these stories to come alive, creating an interesting way for the students of the school to connect with these important Bible Stories.

The project uses books by Bob Hartman and runs a set list of stories throughout the academic year. After much thought, prayer and discussion, the idea has formed that we could start an Open the Book project in our area. We are still in the process of exploring this idea, so the next step would be to see if anyone would be interested to join the team. How often, how many times and how many schools would obviously depend on how many volunteers we could get.

It would be fantastic if volunteers would have at least one free hour a week or a fortnight on a regular basis in term time. It doesn't matter how old you are or how much experience you have - you just need enthusiasm and be willing to share the Bible! The team will be given all the resources and training that they will need.
