In the children's playground, a small figure was making her way slowly and with great determination up the rope climbing frame.

Just a little way above, her father was quietly watching and guiding her: 'Put your hand on rope above you, now move your foot to the left.' She was not far from her goal, the big silver tunnel slide, when suddenly she noticed the other children now clambering up all around her. She hesitated. Now other voices were calling to her: older children, all trying to show they knew a better route for her to take. For a moment the confidence left her and she froze to the spot.

Then another voice broke through again: ' It's all right. I'm here. Move your hand up'.... Confidence restored, she was off again. She knew whose voice to follow. Steadily she pulled herself up the next two rungs to reach her goal. Then, her dad clasped her safely in his arms and they whooshed down the slide together, full of smiles and laughter. The journey through Lent can be a challenge. Sometimes we take one look and decide to give it a miss. Sometimes we find ourselves knocked off course by others on the way. Sometimes we are distracted by voices giving us advice, calling us away from our goal. Yet Lent gives us an opportunity to learn to listen more carefully to the voice of the one who speaks to us in the midst of the clamour: 'I'm here. Keep going. Don't be afraid!'. Whatever challenges you face as you seek to follow the way of Christ this Lent, may you be aware of God's presence, strengthening and guiding you every step of the way.

#### IMPORTANT NOTICE for 9th MARCH


